2nd Quarter (April 1 to June 30, 2018) Population Statistics for the Province of Alberta:

- Total population as of July 1, 2018:
 - **4,307,110**
- Annual growth rate as of July 1, 2018:
 - **1.49%**
 - *Note(s):*
 - Highest it has been since 2015
 - 3rd highest in the country after Ontario (1.79%) and PEI (1.78%)
- 2nd Quarter population change:
 - Addition of **18,783** people (**0.44%** increase)
- Reasons for the 2nd Quarter population change (as a percentage):
 - Net *international* migration – **0.22%**
 - Natural increase – **0.20%**
 - Net *interprovincial* migration – **0.02%**
 - *Note:*
 - Trending back in a positive direction following net outflows of the past two years
- 2nd Quarter net interprovincial migration – gain of **842** people
 - **-1,865** (British Columbia)
 - **1,301** (Saskatchewan)
 - **662** (Manitoba)
 - **277** (Atlantic Canada)
 - **194** (Territories)
 - **173** (Ontario)
 - **100** (Quebec)
