The city needs to work better with Epcor to ensure we are not in the middle trying to make everything work.

With the concerns related to the Complete Streets – we should have a SOLUTION to the concern. The solution will come from working with the Utilities to ensure we are capturing solutions that work for all the parties.

Only doing conduit on arterials – which is a win – though it is dependent on the person in place – it is not a documented acceptance.

On the CCC/FAC Side – there are still some concerns

CCC& FAC - rebates are tied to CCC

- Rebates seem like they are talking longer than usual
- Inspections are happening and they are rejecting them because they are not matching the layers that were originally ok and also not noted in the standards

The Street lighting group- The franchising agreement with Epcor Technologies has been abolished – and are allowing the contractors to do work on their new installs and to manage the maintenance.

Action: Deanna to reach out to Clarence ab Mustapha Abbas Makhdoom - Clarence has been contacted and some thing will be set up when Clarence is back.

Deanna to review rebate timelines with Clarence – Deanna has reached out and is going to be contacting Kayla for further information
